16 to 19 Bursary Fund: management information return

The new 16-19 Bursary Fund is designed to help support those young people who face the greatest barriers to continuing in education or training post 16. Bursary funds are to be used to help pay for the costs related to participation in full-time education, such as the costs of transport, equipment, books, travel, exam costs, school meals, trips, and visits. Students who meet the criteria are invited to apply for a bursary which will be allocated based on individual need.

Bursary Fund guidelines for 16-18 year olds

If you are aged between 16 and 19 years old and think you might struggle with the costs for full-time education or training you may be eligible to receive a bursary. St Thomas More Catholic School operates the scheme in compliance with the ESFA 16-19 Bursary Fund – Guide for 2020-21 and this policy sets out our approach to the use of the Bursary Fund in 2020-21.

16-19 Bursary Fund - St Thomas More Catholic School

The 16-19 Bursary Fund has two elements. Full Bursary Awards Full Bursary awards are for Young people in Care, Care Leavers, young people in receipt of Income Support (or Universal Credit) in their own name or disabled young people in receipt of Employment Support Allowance, who are also in receipt of Disability Allowance (or Personal Independence Payments) - both are eligible to receive a Bursary.

The purpose of the 16 to 19 Bursary Fund is to provide financial support to help students overcome specific barriers to participation so they can remain in education. There are 2 types of 16 to 19 bursaries: a vulnerable bursary of up to £1,200 a year for young people in one of the defined vulnerable groups.
