Gender differences exist in patterns of help seeking for psychological disorder. Women are more likely to seek help from and disclose mental health problems to their primary health care physician while men are more likely to seek specialist mental health care and are the principal users of inpatient care.

### Improvements in mental health care for women ...

Prioritize women's health care: Women need access to reproductive health care, including safe and supportive care throughout pregnancy and childbirth. Provide gender-responsive, trauma-informed care : Correctional facilities must recognize the need for approaches tailored to the mental health needs of women and girls.
