A Medication Aide in adult care homes is an individual who has successfully completed the required Medication Aide course(s) approved by the N.C. Department of Health and Human Services, passed the state written medication exam for unlicensed staff in adult care homes and has competency skills validation at the employing facility.

Medication aides employed in long term care/skilled nursing facilities must have: (1) completed the 24-hour training program approved by the NC Board of Nursing, (2) passed a State-administered competency exam, and (3) be listed on the NC Medication Aide Registry and the Nurse Aide I Registry which are both maintained by the NC Division of Health Service Regulation's Health Care Personnel Registry Section.
